The medical-surgical field of nursing offers a range of jobs spanning acute and long-term health care facilities, social welfare organisations, and international positions, as well as opening the door to a career as an entrepreneur in the field.

A Bachelor of Health Care degree makes you eligible for Master's programmes in Finland and abroad. In Finland, further education options can include health care management, public health or nursing science.
